I want to host a Tournament

A tournament is a one-off event that can span a weekend and includes brackets.

We recommend tournaments for people that are new to organizing competitive events, or that don't have as much time to commit to hosting a several-week league.

NOTE: Please give Motiga at least 2 weeks to review to your event submission.

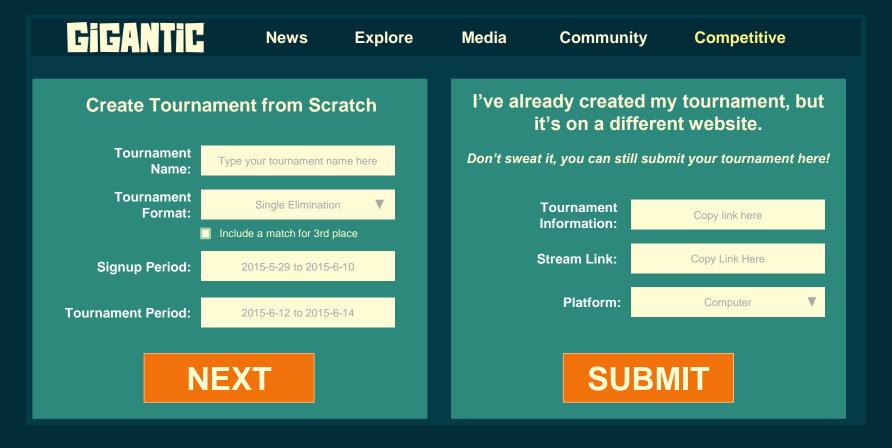
I want to host a League

A league is an event that spans several weeks in which teams can accumulate points and typically ends in a final knockout round with the top teams compete to win.

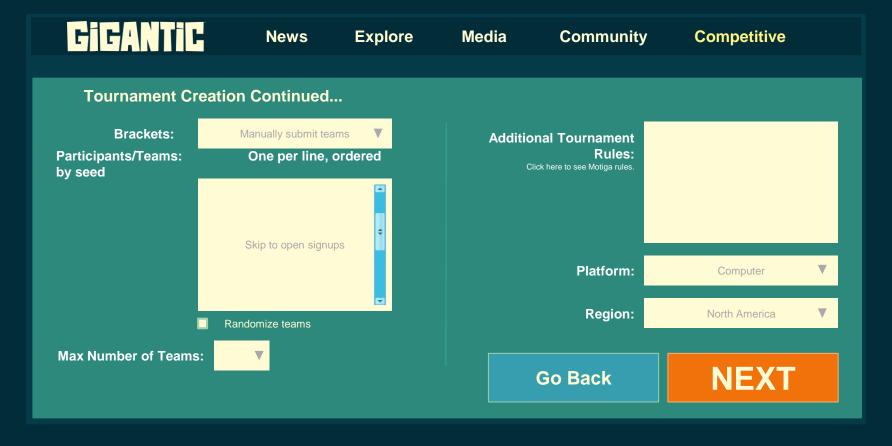
Leagues are better for people that have lots of experience hosting competitive events, as the process tends to have a lot more going on than a tournament would.

NOTE: Please give Motiga at least 2 weeks to review to your event submission.

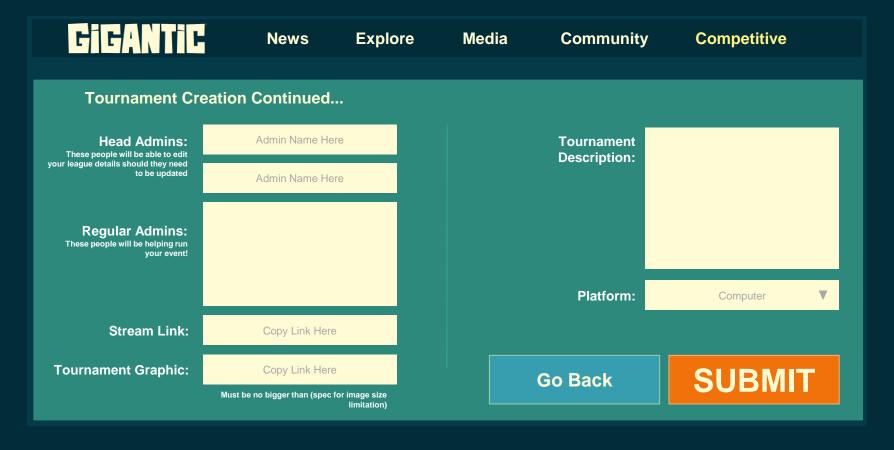

Third Party Event Support

Encourage anyone to run an event through a simplified, easy process.

Acts as the "center of the spider web" in that it wouldn't necessarily take away from what is going on in the community, but rather take everything that's happening and put it in one place.

Makes it easy for teams to sign up.

Easier for organizers to get admin and shoutcasting help.

Gives Motiga and the Gigantic community better visibility into what's going on in the competitive community.

Helps Motiga to better support community driven events.

Submissions must be approved by Motiga before they appear on the event list.

Connecting Influencers/Social Features

Event organizers, shoutcasters, team captains, team managers, admins, coaches - these are the people that keep a competitive scene alive. If we support them by providing a steady place for them to connect, our competitive scene will thrive.

Participants can rate organizers, shoutcasters, etc. on the quality of their organization, skill, etc. and give them constructive feedback.

Suggestion from community - have a page for the person that is similar to something like Rotten Tomatoes where the influencers can give them a rating and reviews and there will be separate rating from the players that participated. Would definitely just want to limit it to people that were either in the event or helped with the event.

Shoutcaster Program (Future)

Help shoutcaster hopefuls hone their skills

Encourage anyone to try shoutcasting by providing an easy step-by-step process to learning shoutcasting

Nice-to-haves

APIs that automatically update tournament results so the event organizer doesn't have to manually update brackets/standings

A way for an event organizer to set the difficulty level so newbies can play without it being gamed (pros smurfing, etc.)
